In 2004 Dennis made his play *Goodnight Joseph Parker* into a feature film starring Paul Sorvino, Debi Mazar and Steven Tyler of Aerosmith. Dennis has also written screenplays for *The Organ Donor* and US television comedy shows: *House of Buggin* and *The Sissy Show*. Dennis has also been a freelance screenwriting instructor, a film competition judge and a panelist at the Global Entertainment and Media Summit. Having moved to New Zealand from the USA in 2007, Dennis is currently Head of Drama Directing and Screenwriting at Auckland's South Seas Film School.
